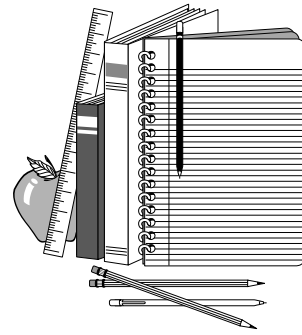


# Supply Lists for Harford Christian School 2020-2021 School Year



## Kindergarten 4

- Regular-size backpack  
(big enough to hold 8 ½ x 11 folder and papers, double straps, no wheels)
- Glue sticks (2 large)
- Eraser (Sanford Pink Pearl or something similar)
- Scissors (Fiskars-not pointed)
- Crayola large size crayons (8 to a pack)
- Crayola regular-size crayons (8 to a pack)
- Crayola water color paint set (8 colors)
- 1 set of markers (10-12 pack) or Expo markers (set of 4) – one or the other
- Paper towels (1 roll)
- Box of tissues (cube style)
- Ziploc baggies (gallon and quart size) – one or the other
- Baby wipes (for sensitive skin)
- Flushable wipes (one container)
- Disinfecting wipes (one container)
- Paint smock (can be an old larger size shirt)
- Lightweight sleeping bag (only for afternoon care)

2. Please label all items with your child's name
3. Alphabet and number flashcards would be helpful for home, but are not necessary for the classroom.

## Kindergarten 5

### To Be Labeled:

- Regular-size backpack (big enough to hold 8 ½ x 11 folder and papers, double straps, no wheels)
- Child's scissors (Fiskars)
- Lightweight sleeping bag with name (only for afternoon care)

### NOT To Be Labeled:

- 1 solid-colored 3-ring zippered pencil pouches with clear window
- 1 1" 3-ring binder with clear front pocket
- 1 3-hole plastic folder with 2 pockets (no brads)
- 1 pencil box
- 3 large Elmer's glue sticks
- 2 Erasers (Sanford Pink Pearl or similar)
- Regular-size Crayola (bold or underlined) crayons (2 boxes of 24 to a pack)
- Box of tissues
- Baby wipes (one container)
- 2 Expo dry-erase markers (chisel tip)

- Boys: bring colored markers and one box of gallon-sized Ziploc bags.
- Girls: 1 bottle of hand sanitizer (pump), and one box of snack-sized Ziploc bags.

## First Grade

- Clear plastic container with lid (needs to be the size of a shoebox, can be found at Target/Walmart, etc. for around \$1, Sterilite is a popular brand)
- 1 inch 3-ring binder
- Crayons (24 count)
- Markers (8 count, wide tip or skinny – your choice)
- Colored pencils (12 count)
- #2 pencils (2 boxes of standard-sized Ticonderoga **Tri-Write** preferred - - these are yellow triangle-shaped pencils)
- 4-count box of colored dry erase markers
- Large pink eraser (x 3)
- Scissors (Fiskars kid-sized; rounded tip not necessary)
- Glue stick (x 4)
- Zippered pencil pouch
- Heavy-duty pocket folder (for use in desk)
- Green plastic pocket folder (needs to have three holes for use in binder)
- Additional pocket folder for music class (also shown in music section)
- Ruler with inches and centimeters (standard 12 inches)
- Students with last names A-M only: package of baby wipes and box of slider gallon-sized baggies
- Students with last names N-Z only: bottle of hand sanitizer, box of slider quart-sized baggies
- Box of tissues
- Book bag
- Lunchbox
- KJV Bible (optional)

\*In 1<sup>st</sup> grade Bible verses are often presented to the students using iPad technology and therefore a Bible is not required for used in our classroom. We would encourage you to purchase a King James version of the Bible to use at home to reinforce the verses and Bible lessons that are taught in class.

- Calculator (not solar)

- 1 composition notebook for journal
- 2 pocket folders needed for **Music** and **Spanish** specials
- 2 boxes of wipes (Clorox)
- 1 box of tissues for classroom use
- Pencil bag (boxes will not fit in desk)
- 1 large eraser
- 1 stretchy fabric book cover

- Planner, notebook or notepad for homework assignments
- Green or purple pens (will need at least three)
- Pencils with erasers (no mechanical pencils)
- Blue or black pens (no fluorescent or pastel colors)
- 1 large boxes of tissues
- 2 containers of Clorox or Lysol wipes
- 1 boxes of wipes (baby wipes preferred)
- 3"x5" lined index cards
- Scissors
- 1 bottle of craft glue or tacky glue (Aleene's)
- Hi-lighter
- Calculator
- 1 pocket folder for **Music** class

- Rulers, compasses and protractors **will be provided** in the classroom for use
- All art supplies (see 5<sup>th</sup>/6<sup>th</sup> grade Art list)

- Scissors
- All art supplies (see 5<sup>th</sup>/6<sup>th</sup> grade art list)
- 1 pack of 3" x 5" cards
- 1 standard size box of tissues
- 1 container of baby wipes or disinfecting wipes
- 4 dry-erase markers
- Calculator

- 1 composition notebook for spelling

## **Core Organizational Requirements by ALL 7-9 teachers:**

7<sup>th</sup> through 9<sup>th</sup> Grade Organizational Scheme:

**\*Each subject area (English, math, Bible, science, history, health, foreign language 1<sup>st</sup> year) will require a separate 1/2" 3-ring binder with pocket dividers (i.e., 8-10 1/2" 3-ring binders). English requests a 1/2" binder for each the grammar and literature areas.**

**\*7<sup>th</sup> grade science and 7<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> history papers can be in a shared notebook divided off for science as a subject.**

- KJV Bible (not revised KJV)
- 8 #2 pencils or lead pencils with lead refill
- 8 red pens
- 8 black/blue pens
- Hi-lighters (yellow preferred)
- Colored pencils (in sets of 10 or 12)
- Scissors
- 12" ruler
- White out
- Eraser (pencil or hand-held)
- Zipper pencil pouch
- Packages of white wide-ruled 3-ring notebook paper (NOT spiral-bound or perforated)
- Package of 8 dividers with pockets (to be shared in several classes)
- Homework Planner (school planners given to 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade)
- 1 marble composition notebook

### **Added Course Specific Needs:**

#### **7<sup>th</sup> History**

- 2 packs of 3"x5" line index cards

#### **7<sup>th</sup> – 9<sup>th</sup> Math**

- 1 calculator should be a TI-30XIIS or TI-30XA, TI-30XS Multiview, and a TI-34  
\*These are scientific calculators that will handle fractions. The dollar store calculator cannot handle fractions. They do not need graphing calculators.
- Lead pencils (#7 with plenty of lead refills and erasers)
- 1 protractor (small with double reading)

- 1 compass with sharp point
- 1 6" ruler
- 9<sup>th</sup> (Algebra I) grade needs graph paper and a red pen for grading  
*\*Have your name on each of these items. You may keep them in room #105*

### **7<sup>th</sup>/8<sup>th</sup> Computer Cycle Class (9 weeks)**

- Plastic pocket folder with 3 prongs (reserved for ONLY Computer Cycle and will remain in the computer room)
- NO 3-ring binders
- Blue/Black pens or pencils

### **7<sup>th</sup>/8<sup>th</sup> Geography Cycle Class (9 weeks)**

- One composition book
- Colored pencils
- One pair of scissors
- College ruled line paper
- 3-hole folder to keep in binder

### **7<sup>th</sup> Life Science**

- 12"/30 mm ruler with mm and inches to be kept in room
- Scissors to be kept in room (please put student name on them)
- 10 pairs of dissection surgical gloves (by December and going forward)
- Composition book (to be kept in the classroom)
- One glue stick
- Colored pencils

### **8<sup>th</sup> Earth Science**

- Composition book (to be kept in the classroom)
- One glue stick

### **9<sup>th</sup> Physical Science**

- 1 calculator

### **10<sup>th</sup> Grade Biology I, Biology II, Physiology, Environmental Science**

- 2 sharpened #2 lead pencils

- Notebook paper

- Notebook dedicated to course or section in shared notebook
- 10 pairs of dissection surgical gloves (Wal-mart, Target, Home Depot) - Not Env.Sci. (needed during the spring months)
- Work gloves for Environmental Science field work
- Biology II Note: Spiral or composition notebook for fruit fly lab data

## **Geometry and Algebra II**

- Spiral notebook for specific note-taking
- Loose-leaf notebook paper for assignments
- Pencils, red pen for grading
- Calculator: Texas Instrument recommended

## **Pre-calculus, Calculus**

- Spiral notebook for specific note-taking
- Pencils, red pen for grading
- Calculator: Texas Instrument – TI-84 Recommended
- Device with internet access to complete assignments

## **Chemistry I, Chemistry II, Physics**

- Separate binder with dividers for notes, assignments, hand-outs, quizzes, and labs
- Hi-liters (4 different colors)
- Calculator, notebook paper, pens and pencils
- Device with internet access to complete assignments

## **10<sup>th</sup> -12<sup>th</sup> Grade English**

- Blue, black, and red ink pens
- Hi-liters
- Notebook paper (not spiral bound)
- 12<sup>th</sup> grade only - manila 10"x12" envelope for research paper (larger is okay but smaller will be a problem), 3x5 and 4x6 cards
- White-out
- Notebook or folder with 5 sections – **Must be for English only!**
- One pack of plastic pocket dividers
- 10<sup>th</sup> - Journal for daily writing entries (composition book preferred)
- 10<sup>th</sup> - One nice 3-prong pocket folder (for writing portfolio)
- 12<sup>th</sup> - Harford County library card (or other local county library card)

## **10<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> Grade History (World, US, Government, Economics)**

- Colored pencils (at least 4 colors for map work)
- 3-ring binder for notes and assignments (no spiral)
- Blue, black, and red ink pens



## **Basic Computing I**

- Plastic pocket folder with 3 prongs (reserved for ONLY Basic Computing I and will remain in the computer room)
- NO 3-ring binders
- Blue/Black pens or pencils
- Any ONE of the following: box of tissues, container of Clorox wipes, bottle of hand sanitizer

## **Basic Computing II**

- Plastic pocket folder with 3 prongs (reserved for ONLY Basic Computing II and will remain in the computer room)
- NO 3-ring binders
- Red Pens
- Blue/Black pens or pencils

## **Desktop Publishing**

- Plastic pocket folder with 3 prongs
- Pens and notebook paper
- 1 1" 3-ring binder

## **Computer Science**

- 1 2" 3-ring binder
- pens
- 1 set (4 divider pages)

## **Consumer Finance**

- Calculator (TI 34 or higher)
- Pencils, 1 red pen
- ½ inch binder with regular notebook paper (NO spiral bound)
- Device with internet access to complete assignments

## **Accounting I, Accounting II**

### **\*All items below are absolutely necessary for course enrollment!**

- Mechanical pencil (5 or 7mm) PENCILS ONLY!
- Calculator (basic)
- White out (tape-type is best)
- 6" or 12" ruler
- 1 – 2" binder (5 dividers)
  - Headings for dividers

## **Foreign Language**

### **Spanish**

- English-Spanish and Spanish-English dictionary (50,000+ entries/paperback)  
\*Avoid University of Chicago Edition
- 2 " 3-ring binders with 5 tab folders
- Notebook paper (college or wide-ruled)
- 2 dry erase markers
- 1 box of tissues

### **Art I**

- 1 inch 3-ring binder with 3 dividers to hold notes and handouts

### **Art II-Advanced**

- Same as Art I above

### **10<sup>th</sup> Grade World History and 11<sup>th</sup> Grade US History**

- Pocket Duo-tang folder
- Notebook paper
- Hi-Liter
