Admissions inquiries remain very strong, as evidenced by a large group that attended our Open House in November and in

Regrettably, this vision is not shared by public education and secularist private schools in our land.

Progress Report

Since our Vision 21 Together "Friendraiser" last October 14, we've continued to make significant strides toward the new classroom building. The vision is coming into focus and we are excited to share the 1st and 2nd floor plans. Completion of this phase of planning is a significant mile marker. The architects can now proceed with serious design details.

But some bad news came with the completion of this phase: the building is projected to cost a half million dollars more than former estimates—a total of \$7.5 million. So, we've begun investing the funds on hand in insured CDs to take advantage of slightly higher interest rates. The architects tell us that when their design work is complete, it will take 18 months to get through the permit process and begin building, so we feel comfortable committing funds to multi-month CDs, striving to earn as much interest as we can to help defray the increased cost. Think of it this way: your gift now to Vision21 Together can yield 4-5% more as we wait for permits.
