PSALM 19:7

The mission of Harford Christian School is to serve families by offering academic excellence within a Christian worldview, all to the glory of God. The faithful preaching and teaching of the Word of God is vital to this mission, and lies at the heart of all we do. This is because Scripture alone possesses the capacity to change people from the inside out.

It is the promise of PSALM 19:7 that compels us to faithfully expose all our students to the power of the Word of God. There, Scripture is called God's LAW. That word simply means that it instructs us in the way we should go. The root of the word actually refers to pointing in a certain direction.

Further, this instruction is PERFECT. That word carries with it two ideas. Throughout the Old Testament, the word is used to describe unblemished sacrifices. The Bible is without error. The passing of time does not alter the rightness of Scripture at all. Another nuance of the word is found when it frequently describes people. When used in that context, the word means complete or whole. God's

Law is without error, and it is complete. It covers all the necessities of life. Everything I need for an acceptable relationship to God is there. Scripture is inerrant and complete— it is Jehovah's perfect law.

But the unique contribution of PSALM 19:7 is its insistence that Scripture will CONVERT THE SOUL. The word convert just means to turn. This is the first necessity of every soul. Because "we have turned everyone to his own way" (Is. 53:6), Jesus said, "Except ye be converted, and become as little children, ye shall not enter into the kingdom of heaven" (MATT. 18:3).

Our souls need continual turning. We have misguided and fallen appetites and are constantly in motion according to those desires. We drift, and we have to be recalibrated. We need to be restored, we need to be revived, we need something to correct us. What does that? The Bible! The Scripture turns the soul!

This is why we are completely preoccupied with God's Word at Harford Christian School. We believe what God says in PSALM 19:7, so we faithfully sow and water, praying that God will give the increase (I COR. 3:7).

Baldwin's Run

In the early 1970s HCS students chose the bald eagle as their mascot. Generations later, they named their eagle Baldwin. Baldwin has cheered HCS on the athletic front for five decades. But now he's entering the greatest contest he's ever run: The Vision 21 Together Marathon.

This marathon includes 8 major hurdles that Baldwin must overcome. Between each of these three smaller hurdles challenge his stride. It's a daunting run. The hurdles are high. Baldwin must be energized for each hurdle. Perseverance is crucial. Enthusiastic spectators must fuel his energy. As they do, he will win—his name is Bald-WIN.


