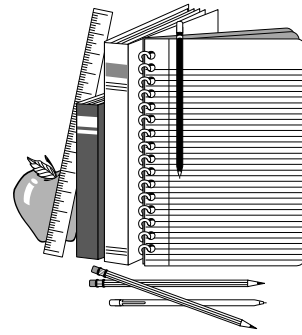


Supply Lists for Harford Christian School 2024-2025 School Year



Kindergarten 4

- Regular-size backpack
(big enough to hold 8 ½ x 11 folder and papers, double straps, no wheels)
- Kids water bottle thermos (leak resistant lid)
- Glue sticks (Elmer's - 2 large)
- Eraser (Sanford Pink Pearl or something similar)
- Scissors (Fiskars) - not pointed
- Crayola large-size crayons – 8-pack
- Crayola regular-size crayons – 16-pack
- Crayola water color paint set (8 colors)
- Crayola washable markers - 10 or 12-pack
- Crayola colored pencils - 10 or 12-pack
- Expo marker - 1 (any color)
- Paint smock (preferably open in front or back)
- Baby wipes - 2 packs (for sensitive skin)
- Disinfecting wipes - 2 containers
- Box of tissues - 2 cube-style box
- Paper towels - 1 roll
- Hand sanitizer – 1 bottle
- Ziploc baggies –
 - gallon-size (student whose last name begins with A-H)
 - sandwich-size (student whose last name begins with I-R)
 - snack-size (student whose last name begins with S-Z)

Kindergarten 4 PM Enrichment (in addition to the above supplies)

- Plastic spoons (students whose last name begins with A-M)
- Plastic forks (students whose last name begins with N-Z)
- Flushable wipes – 1 pack
- Disinfecting wipes – 1 container
- Child-size lightweight sleeping bag
(adult size sleeping bags will not fit in our storage cubbies)

Kindergarten 5

To be labeled with your child's name:

- Clorox wipes (must be Clorox due to allergies)
- Boys – gallon-size Ziploc bags
- Boys - 1 Bag of M&M's
- Girls- snack-size Ziploc bags
- Girls – hand sanitizer
- Tissues – cube style box (4-pack tissue box)



Kindergarten-5 AM Enrichment (in addition to the above supplies) – NOT labeled, please

- 1 pair of child-sized scissors (Fiskars)
- Crayola washable markers - 10 or 12 pack

- 1 box of tissues (cube-size)

First Grade

- Clear plastic container with lid (needs to be the size of a shoebox, can be found at Target/Walmart, etc. for around \$1, Sterilite is a popular brand)
- 1 inch “sturdy” 3-ring binder with pocket in front
- Crayons (24 count)

- Colored pencils (12 count)
- #2 pencils (2 boxes of standard-sized Ticonderoga **Tri-Write** preferred - - these are yellow triangle-shaped pencils)

- Scissors (Fiskars kid-sized; rounded tip not necessary)
- Glue stick (x 6)
- Zippered pencil pouch
- Heavy-duty pocket folder
- 3-hole punched plastic folder for use in binder
- Ruler with inches and centimeters (standard 12 inches)
- 2 boxes of tissues
- Book bag
- Lunchbox
- KJV Bible (optional) **In 1st grade Bible verses are often presented to the students using iPad technology and therefore a Bible is not required for use in our classroom. We would encourage you to purchase a King James version of the Bible to use at home to reinforce the verses and Bible lessons that are taught in class.*

- 2 red pens
- 6-pack of Expo dry erase markers (thin style)
- 2 yellow hi-liters
- 4 large rectangular erasers
- Inch-centimeter ruler
- 4 glue sticks
- 1 box of 24 Crayola crayons
- 1 box of 24 Crayola colored pencils
- 1 thin-zippered pencil pouch – recommend *Five Star* brand
- Pointed scissors
- 1 composition notebook
- 2 reams of wide-ruled notebook paper
- 4 different colored pocket folders (plastic is preferred)
 - 3 empty for seatwork, music, and science/history combined
 - 1 filled with wide-ruled notebook paper

- 1 bottle of craft glue or tacky glue
- Hi-lighter

- Separate binder with dividers for notes, assignments, hand-outs, quizzes, and labs
- Hi-liters (4 different colors)
- Calculator, notebook paper, pens and pencils
- Device with internet access to complete assignments
- Lab book – graph paper bound notebook

9th Grade English

- 1 red pen
- Hi-liters
- 3 ring notebook paper
- 1 composition book

10th -12th Grade English

- Blue, black, and red ink pens
- Hi-liters
- Notebook paper (not spiral bound)
- 12th grade only - manila 10"x12" envelope for research paper (larger is okay but smaller will be a problem), 3x5 and 4x6 cards
- White-out
- Notebook or folder with 5 sections – **Must be for English only!**
- One pack of plastic pocket dividers
- 10th - Journal for daily writing entries (composition book preferred)
- 10th - One nice 3-prong pocket folder (for writing portfolio)

- A spiral sketchbook at least 8" x 11"
 - Does not need to be new
 - Will be stored in the classroom
 - Amazon description needs to contain the words "drawing paper"
