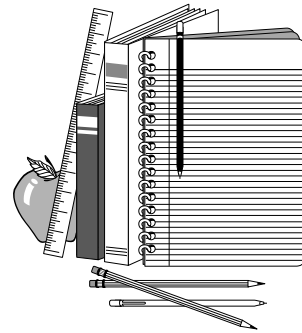


# Supply Lists for Harford Christian School 2025-2026 School Year



## Kindergarten 4

- Regular-size backpack  
**(big enough to hold 8 ½ x 11 folder and papers, double straps, no wheels)**
- Kids water bottle thermos (leak resistant lid)
- Glue sticks (Elmer's - 1 large)
- Scissors (Fiskars) - not pointed
- Crayola large-size crayons – 8-pack
- Crayola regular-size crayons – 16-pack
- Crayola water color paint set (8 colors)
- Crayola washable markers - 10 or 12-pack
- Crayola colored pencils - 10 or 12-pack
- Paint smock (preferably open in front or back)
- Baby wipes - 1 pack (for sensitive skin)
- Disinfecting wipes - 1 container
- Box of tissues - 2 cube-style box
- Paper towels - 2 rolls
- Hand sanitizer – 1 bottle
- Ziploc baggies –
  - 1 quart size

## Kindergarten 4 PM Enrichment (in addition to the above supplies)



## Kindergarten 5

### To be labeled with your child's name:

- Clorox wipes (must be Clorox due to allergies)
- Boys – gallon-size Ziploc bags

## Third Grade

- Standard (not revised) version of the King James Bible
- 3 – one-dozen boxes of Ticonderoga #2 pencils
- 2 red pens
- 4-pack of Expo dry erase markers (thin style)
- 2 yellow highlighters
- 4 large rectangular erasers
- Inch-centimeter ruler (not flexible)
- 4 glue sticks
- Pointed scissors
- 1 box of 24 Crayola crayons
- 1 box of 24 Crayola colored pencils
- 12-pack of Crayola markers
- 1 thin-zippered pencil pouch – recommend *Five Star* brand (please only place 4 pencils, 2 dry erase markers, 1 highlighter, 1 red pen, 1 glue stick, scissors, and 1 rectangle eraser in the pencil pouch)
- 1 wide-ruled composition notebook
- 2 packs of wide-ruled notebook paper
- 3 different colored pocket folders (not red and should be plastic)
  - 1 filled with notebook paper and labelled “Paper”
  - 1 labelled “Science/History”
  - 1 labelled “Seatwork”
- Flashcard sets for home study - - addition, subtraction, multiplication, division
- 3 boxes of tissues (labelled with your teacher's name - - long boxes/not cubed)

- Planner for homework assignments (optional)

- Calculator

### **German**

- German to English and English to German dictionary for at home use

- Webster's New Spanish Dictionary
- 1 basic spiral notebook labelled "Español"
- 1 dry erase marker
- 1 box of tissues

## **Fine Arts**

- **Concert Band**
  - 1 – 2-pocket folder
- **Vocal Choir**
  - 1/2" 3-ring binder
- **Yearbook**
  - 1 2-pocket folder
  - 1 pencil or pen to write with during class

### **Art I**

- 1 inch 3-ring binder with 3 dividers to hold notes and handouts
  - This will be stored in classroom so needs to be dedicated art notebook
- A spiral sketchbook at least 8" x 11"
  - Does not need to be new
  - Will be stored in the classroom

- Amazon description needs to contain the words “drawing paper”

## **Art II-Advanced**

- Same as Art I above
